Body and Soul – Angie Lorenzo	<p>Angie gave a brief review on Body and Soul. Body and Soul is a program designed for African-American churches. It is an African American Spirituality Wellness program. It is specifically meant to have churches implement different activities within their church to make a difference for the congregation to eat healthier; mostly fruits and vegetables, as well as physical activity.</p> <p>Angie has sent out nearly 100 letters to various African-American Church communities. Unfortunately, she has received no responses. Due to her upcoming department closure, she is looking to the Prevention Committee to assist with a more focused outreach program.</p> <p>Fred suggested that we identify just 5 or 6 churches/pastors/health ministers and work with someone on an individual basis with each church. He would be willing to make the first contacts. Angie & Sharon will work with Fred. Any contact suggestions from the Prevention Committee members should be funneled through to Fred.</p> <p>Kendra suggested we need to pre-train the committee members before they make the initial contact with the churches. Several members were willing to attend the training. Summary CEO Cancer Gold Standard – Kendra Sabol	Kendra updated us on the meeting she & Fred had with Brent Briday at Banner Health regarding getting them involved in the Gold Standard program. Very productive meeting... Banner Health is on board. Given the recent announcement of MD Anderson joining forces with Banner Health, this seems like a perfect fit. MD Anderson was the first NCI-designated comprehensive cancer center and the first health care system in the nation to receive the CEO Cancer Gold Standard accreditation. Skin Cancer Awareness	We will address this in a couple of months. We will work with UofA's College of Public Health to develop a new logic model for Skin Cancer. Kendra would like us to have a Skin Cancer Awareness Program in May 2010 similar to Scottsdale HealthCare at the Botanical Gardens.
