Northern Arizona and coalition building	The committee discussed the idea that local advocates are necessary to plan any conference. Sherry Romanoski has been invaluable in this capacity in Tucson. The QOL committee needs to build committee membership and interest among our northern AZ colleagues. A number to potential partners were identified. With local buy-in and support, QOL could host a crash course in either Flagstaff or Prescott in the Fall of 2010.
