Successful Log-In & Top Navigation Bar



With successful log-in, the New Entry/New STEMI screen is defaulted or has been selected to enter new STEMI data. The top navigation bar consists of the following:

Manage Entries with sub tabs of STEMI Entries and CAC Entries (CAC Entries not currently implemented). See Manage Entries/STEMI Entries on page 23.

New Entry with sub tabs of New STEMI and New CAC Entry (New CAC Entry not currently implemented). See New Entry/New STEMI on the next page.

Help not currently implemented.

SIGN OUT Logs you out of the STEMI Application. See page 28 for sign out information.

ENTERING STEMI DATA



The “STEMI Fields Identified” document provides a blank STEMI Entry Form with each field referenced, by number, to the below data requirements. [STEMI Fields Identified.doc](#)

STEMI Entry Field Requirements:

1. EMS PCR/Incident Report ID – Optional field
2. Hospital – **Required field** (Default to User assigned hospital; drop down if Admin)
3. Patient Name (Last and First) - **Required field**
4. DOB or If Unknown Approx. Age - **Required field**
 - a. If DOB – auto-fill Approx. Age field (in years) (Approx Age will be calculated upon the completion of the Arrive Hospital Date)
 - b. If Approx Age - Restrict this field to only allow whole numbers between 0 and 120
 - c. Either DOB or Approx Age must be populated
5. Gender – M/F - **Required field**

FYI - The Radio Buttons....take Gender for example as you tab from Approximate Age field the cursor will be positioned on the Male Radio Button, you can use your space bar to choose Male or use your right arrow to move the selection to Female. You can then use your left and right arrows to change the values. If the cursor is positioned on the Male Radio Button, and you tab again, you'll go to the next field.
6. Transported by POV or EMS - **Required field**
 - a. If POV - gray-out all fields from Transporting Agency through Prehospital 12-lead performed section; position cursor on Hospital Transfer field
 - b. If EMS – Transporting Agency: (drop-down) - **Required field**
 - c. If EMS – Responding Agency: (drop-down) - **Required field** (unless ND selected)
 - i. ND (check box)
 - d. If EMS – Dispatch Date:
 - e. If EMS – Dispatch Time:
 - f. If EMS – Date EMS Notified Hospital - **Required field**
 - g. If EMS – Time EMS Notified Hospital - **Wanted field**

7. Pre-Hospital 12-Lead Performed? - Yes/No - **Required field**
 - a. If No – hide/ gray-out all Pre-Hospital 12-Lead performed section; position cursor on Hospital Transfer field
 - b. If Yes – Was It Successfully Transmitted To ED? – Yes/No - **Required field**
 - c. If Yes – Date and Time ACQUIRED (spelling of acquired needs to be fixed) – **Required fields**
 - d. If Yes – Did EMS Crew CORRECTLY Identify A STEMI? Yes/No
 - i. If No, Was It: A Missed STEMI or An Overcall STEMI (radio buttons) (do not allow if (d) above is Yes)
8. Hospital Transfer? – Yes/No/ND - **Required field**
 - a. If No or ND do not allow From Which Facility and To Which Facility to be populated
 - b. If Yes – From Which Facility? - (drop down) - **Required field**
 - c. If Yes – To Which Facility? - **Required field**
9. Arrive Hospital Date - **Required field**
10. Arrive Hospital Time - **Required field**
11. Initial Arrival Location - (drop down) - **Required field**
 - a. ED; Cath Lab; Other (Can only select one value)
12. Was Patient Admitted? – Yes/No - **Required field**
13. Was an in-hospital ECG performed? Yes/No - **Required field**
 - a. If No, ECG date and time grayed out
 - b. If Yes - 1st ECG Date/time – **Required fields**

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*****You have selected the Manage Entries/Stemi Entries from the top navigation bar.**

As a Facility User, you will only see records for your facility. This screen provides some basic information regarding the STEMI forms contained within the database. These counts are just for the hospital you are authorized to enter data. Over the top of the columns, starting on the left [Show All \(x\)](#) will reflect the total STEMI Forms that have been entered. The other 4 fields will add up to the total provided in [Show All](#). The next field, [Reviewed-Incomplete \(x\)](#) will reflect how many STEMI Forms have been reviewed and have been deemed incomplete. If you click on the [Reviewed-Incomplete](#) box, only STEMI forms that have a status of  Reviewed-Incomplete will be shown on the screen. The next field, [Waiting Approval \(x\)](#) will reflect the number of STEMI Forms which are waiting to be approved. If you click on the [Waiting Approval](#) box, only STEMI forms that have a status of  Waiting Approval will be shown on the screen. The last two fields, [Approved \(x\)](#) and [Approved with edits \(x\)](#) will reflect the number of STEMI Forms that have been Approved or Approved with edits. If you click on the [Approved](#) or [Approved with edits](#), only the STEMI Forms that have a status of  Approved Final or  Approved With Edits will be shown on the screen. To display all STEMI Forms for your facility, click on the [Show All](#) box.

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In addition to the functionality described on the previous page, you can use the column headings to sort STEMI Forms; alone or in conjunction with the Status boxes above the column headings. The columns you can use to sort are: First Name, Last Name, Birth Date, Hospital and Submission Date. If you click on the same column heading, the sort order reverses; for example you click on First Name, the detail data displayed is sorted from A-Z, if you click First Name again the detail data displayed is sorted from Z-A. The Status column heading doesn't sort – you can return to the original Status order by click on the Show All box. The Original Status order is: ★Reviewed-Incomplete, ★Waiting Approval, ★Approved With Edits and ★Approved Final.

A practical application would be if you are working the STEMI forms which are ★Reviewed-Incomplete. You could first click on ★Reviewed-Incomplete then could click on Submission Date. The results of this would be the oldest ★Reviewed-Incomplete STEMI forms at the top of the screen. If you wanted to see the newest ★Reviewed-Incomplete STEMI forms, you would click on Submission Date again, the sort order is now reversed..

A small triangle, next to the column name, reflects the sort order (top to bottom). For First/Last Names & Hospital the up arrow▲ indicates A-Z sort order while the down arrow▼ indicates Z-A sort order. For Birth and Submission dates up arrow▲ indicates oldest to newest while the down arrow▼ indicates newest to oldest.

Managing STEMI Entries



Forms viewed through the Action column functions are very similar to the input form; most detail differences are at the bottom of the forms, which is addressed below.

The Action column provides a way to delete ✖, modify/ change ✎ or view ▶ completed forms.

You can always view ▶ completed forms.

You can only delete ✖ or modify/ change ✎ a form if the status is ★Waiting Approval or ★Reviewed-Incomplete.

Once the form has been ★Approved Final or ★Approved With Edits the delete ✖ and modify/ change ✎ icons will no longer display in the Action column, only the view ▶ Action will be available.

The other columns are as follows:

ID which is a sequential number for each STEMI record.

First Name, Last Name and Birth Date are all related to person who was provided assistance.

Hospital is the receiving hospital and the one that entered the STEMI Form

Submission Date is the date that the form was completed and saved. Currently the data is displayed based on the Status and Submission Date information.

Status values are: : ★Approved Final, ★Approved With Edits, ★Waiting Approval and ★Reviewed-Incomplete



You are in update mode, as long as the form hasn't been approved, you can add or change information and then save the form using the **Update** box (the same edits are in effect as if you are entering an original form), you can undo any changes you may have made using the **Undo Changes** box or you can cancel (leave the form 'as is') using **Cancel** box. The bottom section of the form is below:

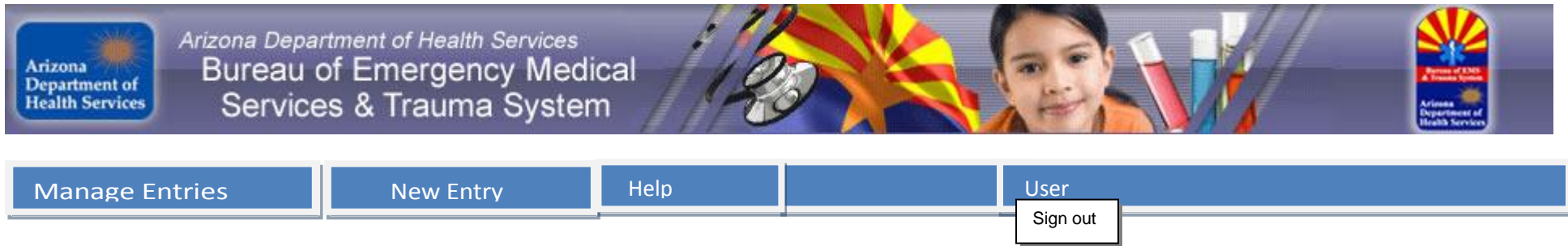
