LMS Course Schedule Changes

- Removed New Employee 1 & 2 column: see new definitions
- Breastfeeding- Required by ALL WIC Employees & No TEST OUT option.
 - Course waved for current employees with 35 hrs course completed (see BF H/O)
- TESTING OUT % Change- Effective April 1, 2011. Eligible Staff must completed with 100%
- FY2011 Civil Rights-Training Added
- Intro to WIC: Increased Time to 4-6 hrs(5 admin CEUs)-see H/O



Breastfeeding Training Status Hand Out

- If Employee has completed or will complete 35 hr BF course by April 2011- select YES. We will not be assign BF LP.
- If Select NO. BF LP will be assigned.
- To Assign an employee the BF LP no matter what, check the appropriate column.
- BF Peer Counselor- Not Assigned BF LP.



Infant Nutrition-WIC Works

- Updated: NO Completion Certificate Required. Staff must complete Post Test in AZ LMS.
- AZ LMS will reconcile staff completed WIC Works course. Supervisors and Nutrition consultants will be notified if discrepancy occurs
- ISSUE: Course will not complete unless EXIT button is used (do not use X).
