



## Public-Private Partnership Opportunity



### 4.2.1 Approx. 80 beds on the Civil Campus

The Civil Campus consists of six treatment units specializing in providing services to adults who are civilly committed as a danger to self, danger to others, gravely disabled and/or persistently and acutely disabled, who have completed a mandatory 25 days of treatment in a community inpatient setting prior to admission. Two of the buildings on the Civil Campus (Ironwood and Desert Sage) have second floors that are currently vacant and accessible to each other via a second floor bridge and by elevator. This is four units, each with approximately 20 beds. A partner can either use the second floors of these two buildings or the first and second floors of the Ironwood building. The beds on these vacant units were built for inpatient use, but could be used for other purposes. The infrastructure is in good standing and there would be minimal work needed to get them up and running.

### Highlights/Benefits

- Building is located within a secure perimeter
- Layout of the buildings provides separation on each unit creating two distinct and separate areas for the treatment of patients
- Each floor on each of the units has attached administrative office areas with break rooms and conference rooms
- The entire Civil Hospital fire alarm system was updated and the fire damper actuators were all replaced this year
