




Non-Fatal Inpatient Hospitalizations for Injuries Among Children Under 5 Years, Arizona 2007

Arizona children under 5 years old were hospitalized 1,078 times for non-fatal injuries in 2007.

Non-fatal injuries among Arizona children resulted in **\$28.2 million** in inpatient hospital charges.




94% of non-fatal injury-related early childhood inpatient hospitalizations were due to unintentional injuries.



The longest hospital stay for a non-fatal early childhood injury was **105 days**. The average inpatient hospital stay was 3 days.

On average, the charges for each non-fatal inpatient hospitalization totaled \$26,124.

Non-Fatal Injury-Related Inpatient Hospitalizations by Month, Arizona 2007




Prevent early childhood injuries!
