

# Exciting news from DPS!

The Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) has just announced in a [recent press release](#) that a new online application system for fingerprint clearance cards has been implemented and is now available for use.

The application process will require you to have the following information available:

During the application process, you will make an appointment to have your fingerprints captured electronically via Livescan fingerprinting. You will need to have two forms of ID (including a government-issued photo ID) and your appointment number when you go to your Livescan appointment.

*There is a small fee for using this online system, but the fees for the Clearance Cards remain the same.*
