

Definitions


- o ePCR = electronic patient care record
- o AZ PIERS = Arizona Prehospital Information and EMS Registry System
- o NEMSIS = National EMS Information System
- o ROSC = Return of Spontaneous Circulation
- o ASA = Aspirin
- o STEMI = ST elevation myocardial infarction

Why it matters?

- o Links EMS calls to patient outcomes
- o Under-reporting of performance measures
- o Affects funding for agency and state
- o Improves patient outcomes
 - o Guides training
- o Creates benchmarks
- o Reimbursement
 - o Billings
 - o Income for personnel
 - o Grant opportunities



STEMI

- o 12 lead ECG obtained and time
- o STEMI alert/notification
- o ASA administration or contraindication
 - o Prior to arrival (ie. patient self-administered)



Cardiac Arrest

- o CPR prior to arrival
- o AED used prior to arrival
- o Witnessed or unwitnessed
- o Estimated time of arrest
- o Initial rhythm
- o ROSC
- o Final Rhythm



Cardiac Arrest Data

- o Cardiac arrest data reported to both AZ PIERS and AZ SHARE
- o AZ SHARE is statewide repository for cardiac arrest data
- o This data is reported back to each individual agency annually
- o This report included ultimate patient outcomes from hospital



Stroke

- o FAST/Cincinnati/stroke scale
- o Blood glucose
- o Stroke alert/notification
- o Time of onset
