THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES has found, under the authority of A.R.S. § 36-2232 et seq and Pursuant to Department of Health Services rules, that public necessity requires the operation of

CITY OF BISBEE dba BISBEE FIRE DEPARTMENT

as a ground ALS and BLS ambulance service in the State of Arizona for the transportation of individuals who are sick, injured, wounded or otherwise incapacitated or helpless within the following service area, with the following central operations station and response times:

1. Service Area:

Beginning at a point where the San Pedro River intersects with the US/Mexico Border, then North along the San Pedro River to a point where the San Pedro River intersects with the southern line of Section 19, T21S R22E, then on a straight line northeast to the northeast corner of Section 23, T21S R22E, then to Mile Marker 326 on AZ Route 80, then to the Southwest corner of the Northwest ¼ of Section 8, T21S R23E, then to the Northeast corner of Section 9, T21S R23E, then East to the Northeast corner of Section 12, T21S R23E, then South to the Southwest corner of Section 19, T21S R24E, then east to the Northeast corner of Section 25, T21S R24E, then South to the Southwest corner of the Northwest ¼ of Section 19, T22S R25E, then to the Southeast corner of Section 22, T22S R25E, then North to the Northwest corner of the Southwest ¼ of Section 14, T22S R25E, then East to the Northeast corner of the Southeast ¼ of Section 16, T22S R26E, then following the Section lines South to the Southeast corner of Section 21, T24S R26E at the Arizona/Mexico border, then West along the Arizona/Mexico border to a point where the San Pedro River intersects with the US/Mexico Border, or point of beginning.

Now, therefore, by virtue of the authority vested in the Arizona Department of Health Services, under the constitution and laws of the State of Arizona, does hereby grant this

CERTIFICATE OF NECESSITY

authorizing the operation of the aforesaid ambulance service for a period ending August 31, 2018 unless for cause sooner amended, suspended, revoked or terminated subject to the decisions and orders, and rules of the Department.

PROVIDED, that this certificate shall not be assigned nor transferred unless authorized by the Arizona Department of Health Services.

- b. *Twenty (20) minutes on 96.5% to 98% of all ambulance calls.*
- c. *Thirty (30) minutes on 98.5% to 100% of all ambulance calls.*
