THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES has found, under the authority of A.R.S. § 36-2232 et seq and Pursuant to Department of Health Services rules, that public necessity requires the operation of

NORTHWEST FIRE DISTRICT

as a ground ALS ambulance service in the State of Arizona for the transportation of individuals who are sick, injured, wounded or otherwise incapacitated or helpless within the following service area, with the following central operations station and response times:

1. Service Area: *All of the legal geographic boundaries of the Northwest Fire District.*
2. Central Operating Station: *5225 W. Massingale Rd, Tucson, AZ 85743*
3. Response Times:
 - a. *Ten (10) minutes on ninety (90) percent of all ambulance calls.*
 - b. *Fifteen (15) minutes on ninety-nine (99) percent of all ambulance calls.*
4. Type of Service: *Immediate Response Transports.*
5. Hours of Operation: *24 hours per day – 7 days per week*

Now, therefore, by virtue of the authority vested in the Arizona department of Health Services, under the constitution and laws of the State of Arizona, does hereby grant this


CERTIFICATE OF NECESSITY

authorizing the operation of the aforesaid ambulance service for a period ending March 26, 2019 unless for cause sooner amended, suspended, revoked or terminated subject to the decisions and orders, and rules of the Department.
