

## INSTRUCTIONS & INFORMATION: COUNTY HEALTH ASSESSMENT/IMPROVEMENT PLAN & COMMUNITY PARAMEDICINE HEALTH PRIORITIES CROSSWALK

### INTRODUCTION:

The Bureau of EMS and Trauma System (Bureau) within the Arizona Department of Health Services conducted a survey in January 2015 of EMS and fire agencies in Arizona to determine the extent of community paramedicine program development and implementation across the state. The results of the survey were published around April 2015. This Crosswalk Tool is the second component of the survey results.

The Crosswalk Tool enables fire department and non-fire-based ambulance agencies to view the status of their respective community paramedicine programs and enables county health departments to view what EMS and fire agencies in their respective counties are developing or providing community paramedicine services. The status of any given fire/EMS agency is based on data obtained and verified back in March 2015. The status of these community paramedicine programs may have changed since that time; therefore, please contact the fire/EMS agency of interest to confirm any changes to what is show in this Crosswalk Tool for that specific agency.

The Crosswalk Tool enables county health departments and fire/EMS agencies to compare their respective targeted health priorities by clicking the various cells containing links to program information. The respective county health department content includes Contact Information, Email Addresses, Phone Numbers, Location Addresses, and hyperlinks to the the respective countys' Community Health Assessment and Community Health Improvement Plan. The respective fire/EMS agency content includes Contact Information, Email Addresses, Phone Numbers, Location Addresses, community paramedicine targeted health conditions, services provided, access information, and other program details.

### EXPLANATION OF CROSSWALK FIELDS:

Using Maricopa County as an example, the far left column contains Maricopa County Health Department information, including a list of health concerns identified from the CHA and/or CHIP. Red-text concerns are the top priority health concerns listed by Maricopa County. The headers for the 17 columns to the right of the County column list the community paramedicine program targeted health conditions identified by the fire/EMS agencies in their respective surveys.

The red-colored cells reflect a health concern/condition match between the fire/EMS agency and Maricopa County Health Department. For example, there are two fire/EMS agencies that identified "Diabetes" as a targeted health condition for their community paramedicine program; similarly, Maricooa County Health Department identified "Diabetes as one of its top 5 health priorities. The red-text cells contain alpha-numeric codes (Fire/EMS Codes) that correspond to each fire/EMS agency that completed the CP Survey in March 2015.

Clicking the agency name hyperlink to access the table of EMS/Fire Agency CP information. Scroll down the table to locate the agency of interest. Note: Individual EMS/Fire CP Profile information may have changed since the March 2015 Survey was completed.
