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
Arizona District 1

- In District 1 each taxpayer directly contributed at least **\$86** for the care of injured patients in 2006


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Arizona District 1: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 2: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 3: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 4: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 5: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 6: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 7: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 8: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 9: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 10: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 11: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 12: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 13: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 14: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 15: Cause of Injury



Arizona District 15: Primary Payor Mix





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


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Arizona District 16: Cause of Injury



Arizona District 16: Primary Payor Mix





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


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Arizona District 17: Cause of Injury

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


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Arizona District 18: Cause of Injury








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Arizona District 20: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 21: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 22: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 23: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 24: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 25: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 26: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 27: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 28: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 29: Cause of Injury




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Arizona District 30: Cause of Injury




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Apache County: Cause of Injury




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Cochise County: Cause of Injury




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Coconino County: Cause of Injury




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Gila County: Cause of Injury




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Graham County: Cause of Injury




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Greenlee County: Cause of Injury




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La Paz County: Cause of Injury






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Mohave County: Cause of Injury








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Pima County: Cause of Injury




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Pinal County: Cause of Injury




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Santa Cruz County: Cause of Injury




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Yavapai County: Cause of Injury






