Healthy People 2010 Objective:


Increase the proportion of children who participate in fully operational population-based immunization registries. Target is set as 95% of the children under the age of 6.

Performance Measures:

The U. S. Census estimates Arizona's 2008 population to be 6,500,000.

ASIIS contains almost 4,500,000 individuals including 2,345,291 children under the age of 18.

ASIIS is pre-populated with birth certificate data.
