

Arizona Commodity Supplemental Food Program

- The Arizona Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) is a federally funded food distribution program that provides a once-a-month food package to participants.
- In some Arizona counties, the program is called “Food Plus.”
- Services are offered in Cochise, Coconino, Gila, La Paz, Maricopa, Mohave, Pima, Pinal, Santa Cruz, Yavapai, and Yuma counties.
- The program is designed to improve health with nutritious USDA foods.
- Benefits of this program include nutrition education, reduction of malnutrition in seniors, and immunization referrals.

You can participate if you are 60 years of age or older.
