Our Services

Support: A toll-free helpline with secure voice-message

Direct Services: Trained ASAFSF volunteer-members serve 3 victims on an average per day, providing financial assistance for child care, rent, lawyers' fees, transportation, emergent personal needs; family advocates accompany and support affected families to courts, medical and lawyers' appointments, and resource centers while maintaining strict confidentiality for victims' and advocates' safety

Trainings: Organize general and culture-specific advocacy training for members and volunteers, and mandatory 40 hours training for direct service providers

Parenting Help: Assist families to readjust to positive parenting

Community Outreach: Conferences and other community outreach events are held each year
