



## **CULTURAL COMPETENCY WORKSHOP**

Cultural Competence can be defined as the awareness, knowledge, and skills necessary to counsel effectively and ethically across cultural differences. The awareness of these diverse components is what allows counseling professionals to assess the development of their own multicultural aptitude.

With minority Americans expected to comprise more than 40 percent of the U.S. population by 2035 and 47 percent by 2050 addressing the health needs has become an increasingly visible public policy goal.

The workshops raise organizational awareness, starts focused conversations, contribute to the development of equity action plans, and tracks organizational change. The workshops are designed to help participants get better results in their work by providing a resource for analysis and strategies related to issues of inequity surrounding health. We utilize the Annie. E. Casey Foundation, Race Matters- evidence based model curriculum.

This workshop provides both **\*Cultural Competency\*** and **\*Serving Diverse Populations\*** education to professional counselors, substance abuse counselors, social workers, marriage and family therapists, governmental agencies, hospitals, Doctor's offices, health care workers, health care providers and community workers.

The cost is \$300.00.
