NONIONIZING FEE SCHEDULE

The Nonionizing Compliance Program charges an **APPLICATION FEE** for new applicants and an **ANNUAL FEE** for existing registrations. Annual Fee Notices are typically mailed between Thanksgiving and December 25 each year for the following year and are due and payable by January 1 (even without the notice by rule).

The **APPLICATION** or **ANNUAL FEE** charged is based on the number of units registered at the time of billing and the discipline, except for the Laser Light Shows. The following chart lists the disciplines and their per unit charge:

Tanning Facility (per device/bed).....	\$28.00
Class A Laser Facility (1-10 lasers).....	\$175.00
Class B Laser Facility (11-49 lasers).....	\$408.00
Class C Laser Facility (50+ lasers).....	\$699.00
Laser Light Show (per year).....	\$408.00
Medical Laser Facility (per surgical laser).....	\$47.00
(IPL) Class II/Cosmetic Laser (per unit).....	\$47.00
Medical RF Device Facility (per unit).....	\$47.00
Class A Industrial RF Facility (1-5 units).....	\$70.00
Class B Industrial RF Facility (6-20 units).....	\$210.00
Class C Industrial RF Facility (21+ units).....	\$349.00
Other Radiation Machine.....	Full Cost

There is no charge for adding units during the year. Likewise, there are no refunds during the year for deleting units. Refunds are processed for balancing fee payment errors only.

You must apply for a new registration of your nonionizing equipment within 30 days of installation. Registration is not complete until the **APPLICATION FEE** payment is received by the Agency.

If your facility has not been previously registered, or if your facility is opening an additional location, you will be charged the **APPLICATION FEE**. This **APPLICATION FEE** is not pro-rated.

If you have problems calculating the fee, please call and someone will assist you.

The Agency is not currently set up to accept credit cards or to make payment over the Internet.

Your cancelled check will serve as your receipt.
