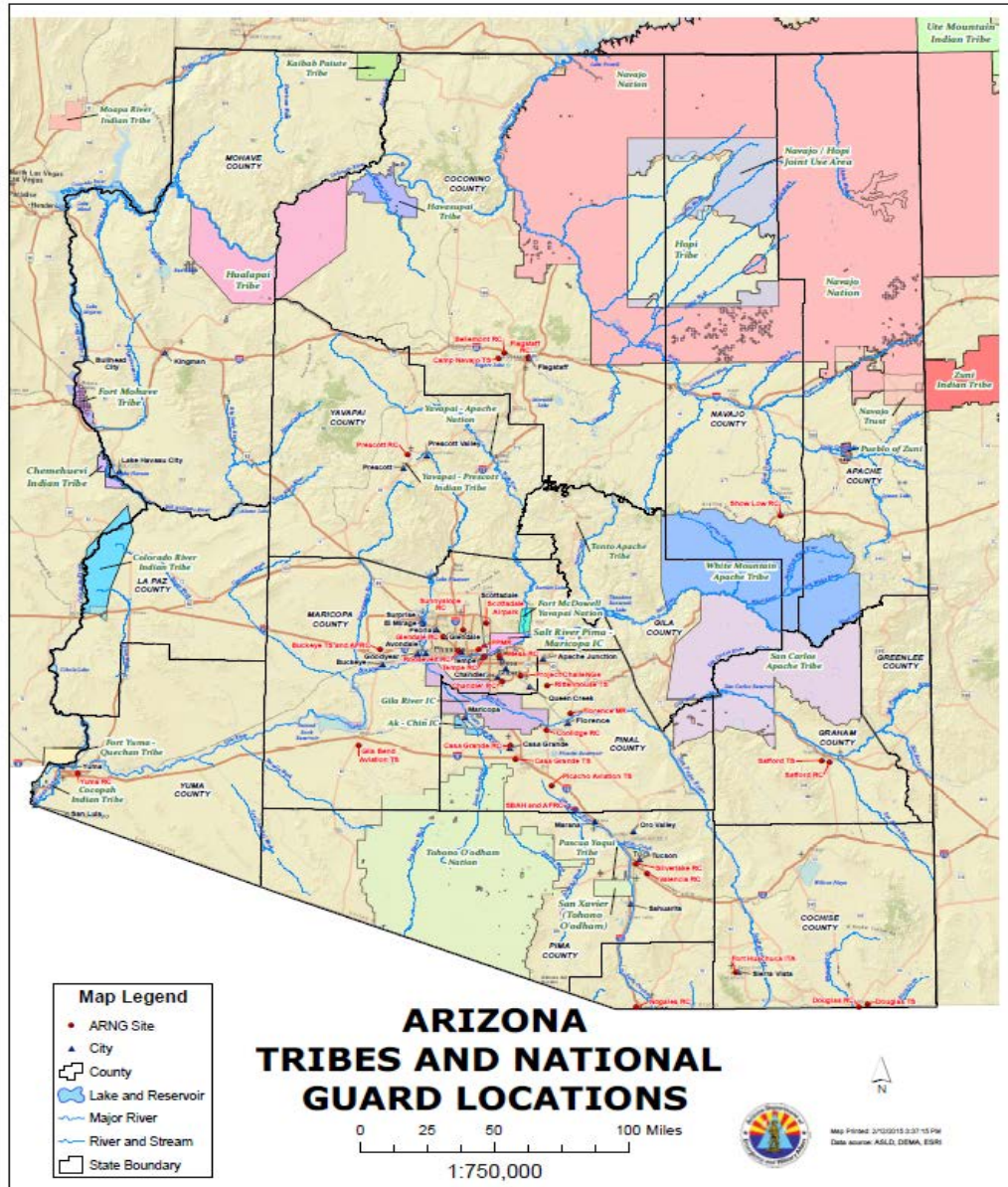

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- 28 Mission Ready Packages are mission tailored and scalable – requests should be for a capability not a specific piece of equipment/package
- Provide visibility on validated, available and authorized capabilities

Arizona Department of Emergency and Military Affairs Request Process



Requesting Organization
(Local/State/Federal/Tribal)

Send request for support to AZ Dept. Of Emergency and Military Affairs Division of Emergency Management

Arizona Division of Emergency Management will process the request and if no other recourse is available that meet the requirements request AZNG support

DEMA

Processes the request and determines what Mission Ready Packages meet the mission requirements.

Joint Task Force AZ
Department of Military
Support (AZNG)

JTF-AZ will task the force providers (Army National Guard/ Air National Guard) with providing the required Mission Ready Packages

Receives the tasking from JTF-AZ and tasks the required unit(s)

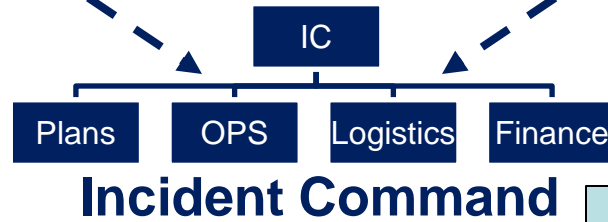
Begins alert notification and prepares for mission in support of incident commander/emergency management agency
