

ALL CHILDREN ARE AT RISK FOR LEAD POISONING

Testing at **1** and **2** is what we do. Contact your child's Healthcare Provider to schedule a blood lead test.

WHAT IF WE TOLD YOU THAT...



- ✓ Lead poisoning can cause permanent brain damage if not detected early
- ✓ The only way to know if your child has been exposed to lead is with a blood test
- ✓ Lead testing can prevent further exposure and reduce damage to children's health



ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES

State regulations require that all children enrolled in AHCCCS receive a blood lead test at 12 and 24 months of age or at least once before the age of 6 if not previously tested. ADHS recommends testing all children not covered by AHCCCS if they live in a targeted high risk zip code.
