WHEREAS, during the first full week of April each year, the American Public Health Association brings communities across the United States together to recognize the contributions of public health, highlight issues that are important to improving the nation's health, and raise awareness that where people live, work, play, recreate, retire, visit, do business, and get an education can impact their health; and

WHEREAS, the nationally accredited Arizona Department of Health Services joins the American Public Health Association in recognizing National Public Health Week to promote health and wellness for all Arizonans and celebrate Arizona's public health system and professionals; and

WHEREAS, by actively working together, Arizona's public health partners can build healthier communities to ultimately become the healthiest state in the Nation.
