The Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) and the Arizona Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics (AzaAP) is inviting you to identify a staff member(s) within your school/district who may be interested in receiving training to become a certified ADHS Vision Screening Trainer.

These training sessions and certifications will be at no cost to schools or participants.

By designating an eligible staff member, your school/district will receive:

- access to FREE Vision Screening Trainer Certification,
- flexibility to train and certify screeners as needed to meet the needs of your community, and
- ongoing assistance and support from program staff

The designated staff member will:

- attend a FREE training to become a Certified Vision Screening Trainer,
- agree to coordinate and provide free vision screening training within your school/district as part of their existing staff responsibilities (training outside of their program is not required), and
- submit training rosters to the program according to the Vision Screening Rules

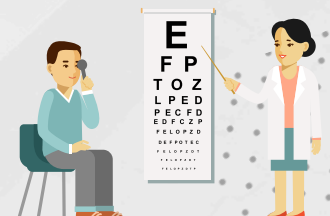
QUALIFICATIONS TO BECOME A VISION TRAINER

The designated staff member must meet both the education and experience criteria in one of the following categories.

Category	Education		Experience
1	Currently a registered nurse who is providing school health services	&	At least 100 vision screenings in the last 12 months
2	Currently a vision screener who's had a certificate for the last 5 years	&	At least 1,000 vision screenings in the last 5 years
3	30 college or university semester credits related to optometry, ophthalmology, or instruction of students with visual impairment	&	At least 100 vision screenings in the last 12 months
4	Currently licensed in Arizona as an optometrist or ophthalmologist	&	At least 25 vision screenings in the last 12 months

3	30 college or university semester credits related to audiology or speech-language pathology	&	At least 100 hearing screenings in the last 12 months
4	Currently licensed in Arizona as an audiologist	&	At least 25 hearing screenings in the last 12 months
